**Action Taken**: After discussion, Kristen Rutland moved to repeal rule 64B20.3001, F.A.C. and complete a technical change to rule 64B20.3.015, F.A.C. Dr. Boyev seconded the motion. Motion passed

**Action Taken**: After discussion, Kristen Rutland moved to approve the proposed rule changes to rule 64B20-2.003, rule 64B20-4.00, and rule 64B20-2.00, F.A.C. to incorporate the changes in law deleting the requirement for initial licensure applicants to take an HIV/AIDs course and a Medical Errors course, Dr. Boyev seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Action on SERC Questions: Dr. Rahe moved to find that the proposed changes will not have an adverse impact on small businesses or directly or indirectly increase regulatory cost to any entity in excess of \$200.000 in the aggregate in Florida within one year after implementation of the rule and a SERC was not needed. Dr. Johnson seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
