1. July 22, 2015 – Full Board Meeting

Minutes of the July 22, 2015, General Business Meeting were reviewed. Motion to accept the minutes was made by Dr. Guerreiro and seconded by Ms. Rutland. Vote 5 ayes, 0 opposed; Motion carried

Section General Board Business ended at 9:01 a.m. Section Discipline Cases began at 9:01 a.m.

FINAL ORDERS BY SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT:

 George Sinclair, Au.D., SLP – Case Number 2014-01428
 Ms. Rutland recused due to participation on the Probable Cause Panel Respondent was present and was not represented by counsel, Christopher Mast.

An Administrative Complaint filed by the Department charged Respondent with violation of ss. 468.1295(1)(bb) and 468.1225, Fla. Stat., and rule 64B20-8.008, F.A.C., by failing to meet the minimal requirements in the fitting and sale of hearing aids. Respondent and the department negotiated a proposed settlement agreement.

The prosecutor advised the board that the settlement agreement contained the following provisions:

- reprimand;
- administrative fine of \$2,000.00 payable within 3 years of the filing of the Final Order;
- costs of \$3,350 payable within 3 years of the filing of the Final Order;

• unspecified number of hours continuing education for recordkeeping within 12 months after the filing of the Final Order. NOTE: Prior to this meeting, the Respondent completed a continuing education course in addressing audiometric testing in the fitting and sale of hearing aids. Respondent has been licensed for 16 years without any discipline and took the CE courses without waiting for resolution by the board, showing his willingness to cooperate with discipline.

Respondent said he only received notice on Saturday and it didn't say his lawyer had to be here. Board counsel asked if he wished to proceed without counsel, to which Respondent responded that he wished to proceed.

 Ms. Rutland was recused due to participation on the Probable Cause Panel. Respondent was not present and was not represented by counsel.

An Administrative Complaint alleging that Respondent violated ss. 468.1295(1)(r), 468.1295(1)(bb), and 468.1245(2), Fla. Stat., and/or 64B20-9.006, F.A.C., by representing or implying that a hearing aid was custom made or specially fabricated for a particular patient when the hearing aid had been made for another patient, and failed to provide the customer with a receipt and/or failed to maintain records of the hearing aid cost. Respondent failed to file an election of rights or other responsive pleading that disputed the allegations of the Administrative Complaint.

Motion that the Respondent was properly served and waived her right to a hearing made by Dr. Rahe, second by Dr. Guerreiro.

Vote: 4 yeas / 0 opposed; Motion carried

Motion to adopt the materials in the investigative file into evidence and adopt the findings of fact as stated in the Administrative Complaint was made by Dr. Rahe, second by Dr. Guerreiro. Vote: 4 yeas / 0 opposed; Motion carried

Motion to adopt the conclusions of law and find that the facts support a violation of the Practice Act as charged in the administrative complaint made by Dr. Rahe, second by Dr. Guerreiro. Vote: 4 yeas / 0 opposed; Motion carried

Department recommendation for discipline: reprimand with fine in the amount of \$5,000 and probation for one year.

Discussion

The Board questioned whether a reprimand, a \$5,000 fine, and a 1 year probation was enough given the circumstances as this is a clear violation for what the profession requires to protect the citizens of Florida. Dr. Guerreiro recommended revocation. Board counsel and prosecutor advised that aggravating factors would be needed to support revocation. The board asked if additional discipline cases can be considered as an aggravating factor. Board counsel provided the usual aggravating factors that may be considered, which she stated do not appear to exist in this instance. Prosecution advised that there is a second case where the board may wish to consider a stronger penalty.

Motion to impose discipline as recommended by the Department payable within 90 days of the filing of the final order with standard probation terms found in rule made by Dr. Guerreiro, second by Dr. Boyev. Vote: 4 yeas / 0 opposed; Motion carried

 Stephen William Goff, Au.D. – case number 2013-18551 and 2013-13989 Ms. Rutland was recused due to participation on the Probable Cause Panel. Respondent was not present and was not represented by counsel.

An Administrative Complaint alleging that Respondent violated ss. 468.1295(1)(d), 456.072(1)(m), 468.1296(1)(bb), Fla. Stat., and rule 64B20-9.006, F.A.C., by knowingly filing a false report, employing a trick or scheme in the practice of audiology, failed to create and/or maintain records of fitting and sale of hearing aids and failed to follow appropriate procedures in the fitting and sale of hearing aids. Respondent failed to file an election of rights or other responsive pleading that disputed the allegations of the Administrative Complaint.

Motion that the Respondent was properly served and waived her right to a hearing made by Dr. Guerreiro, second by Dr. Rahe.

Vote: 4 yeas / 0 opposed; Motion carried

Motion to adopt the materials in the investigative file into evidence and adopt the findings of fact as stated in the Administrative Complaint was made by Dr. Guerreiro, second by Dr. Rahe. Vote: 4 yeas / 0 opposed; Motion carried

Discussion

Dr. Guerreiro asked if Respondent defrauded his place of employment since payments were made directly to his personal account, so his employer was also harmed. The prosecutor commented that there are criminal charges pending.

Department recommendation for discipline: reprimand, fine in the amount of \$10,000, 1 year probation with conditions, continuing education hours in ethics and the procedure of fitting and sale of hearing aids. Counsel stated that the board may wish to impose greater discipline based on the following aggravating factors: financial exploitation, number of violations, monetary harm to patients, board resolved a second disciplinary case with similar circumstances.

Motion to revoke the license in addition to a fine in the amount of \$10,000 made by Dr. Rahe, second by Dr. Guerreiro. Vote: 4 yeas / 0 opposed; Motion carried

Department recommendation for costs: \$2,436.51 for case number 2013-18551; \$1,572.14 for case number 2013-13989, the total of which is \$4,008.64 to be paid within one year.

LICENSURE APPLICATION APPEARANCES:

 Kimberly Bagley, file 14654 – Speech Language Pathologist Applicant was present and was not represented by counsel.

Applicant answered in the affirmative to a health history question. Applicant supplied documentation from her treating physician in support of her application.

Discussion:

Applicant stated she was in process of divorcing and her condition had been exacerbated due to the stress. Dr. Johnson asked if PRN would be available. Board counsel said the Board could grant a license conditional on the applicant being cleared to practice through PRN. Board counsel explained the impaired practitioner program. Dr. Guerreiro stated applicant had met all other requirements and her licenses in other states are all in good standing.

Motion to grant a license conditioned on PRN finding applicant safe to practice made by Dr. Guerreiro, second by Dr. Boyev. Vote: unanimous. Motion carried

Motion to complete the PRN evaluation within 6 months made by Dr. Guerreiro, second by Dr. Boyev. Vote: unanimous. Motion carried

8. Lori Sarnoff, file 14410 – Speech Language Pathologist Applicant was present and was not represented by counsel.

Applicant answered in the affirmative to a health history question. Applicant supplied documentation from her treating physician in support of her application.

Discussion:

Applicant stated she has been symptom free since 4.5 years ago after her hospitalization. Dr. Johnson asked whether a PRN referral should be imposed. Dr. Boyev asked if she was being seen currently to which the applicant replied she is under treatment.

Motion made by Dr. Guerreiro to grant the license based upon PRN recommendation that applicant is safe to practice, seconded by Dr. Rahe with a friendly amendment to limit the time frame for compliance to 6 months from the date of the order.

Vote: unanimous. Motion carried

9. Raylennis Aguilera, file 7063 – Provisional Speech Language Pathologist Applicant was present and was not represented by counsel.

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Applicant received her education outside of the United States. The board staff were not able to reconcile Applicant's education with rule 64B20-2.002(1)(a) and (b), F.A.C.

Discussion:

Dr. Johnson stated the board could not review the applicant's liaison information because of the short timeframe before the meeting. Dr. Guerreiro stated applicant's special education was confirmed as being in accord with the Board's general requirements, but he could not find the applicant's speech education. Applicant handed out education information set out in a table. Dr. Johnson could not find 36 graduate credits to meet the speech language credit requirements; he found 70 credits total, but only 36 credits for speech. Applicant opined that other courses are important for a speech language pathologist despite not being speech courses. Dr. Boyev found 25 credits directly related to speech and asked what other types of courses could be included. Based on the additional courses for sign language and stimulation, anatomy and physiology, deviations of sensory development, the Board found 36 credits in speech.

Motion made by Dr. Boyev to grant the license, seconded by Dr. Guerreiro. Vote: unanimous. Motion carried

Time ended: 9:53 a.m.

 Lourdes Hernandez de la Rosa, file 6507 – Provisional Speech Language Pathologist Applicant was present and was represented by a translator/ representative: Jonah Venguera as translator.

Applicant received her education outside of the United States. The board staff were not able to reconcile Applicant's education with rule 64B20-2.002(1)(a) and (b), F.A.C. Applicant withdrew her application then reapplied, providing additional information. This matter is before the board as a reapplication for licensure.

Discussion:

Applicant did not want to make a statement. Dr. Johnson stated the board could not review the applicant's information because of the short timeframe before the meeting. Applicant presented evidence that she holds a specialist in speech language, then a bachelor's degree, and finally received her master's degree in 1990. Page 1401 provided a chart of the courses taken for graduate courses.

Motion made by Dr. Guerreiro to grant the license and seconded by Dr. Rahe. Vote: unanimous. Motion carried

Time ended: 9:58 a.m.

12. Manuela Semino, file 2782 – Speech Language Pathology Assistant Applicant was present and was represented by a translator/ representative.

Applicant received her education outside of the United States. The board staff were not able to reconcile Applicant's education with rule 64B20-2.002(1)(a) and (b), F.A.C.

Discussion:

Dr. Johnson stated the board could not review the applicant's information because of the short timeframe before the meeting. Applicant is in the process of completing her master's degree on physiological studies online through an unaccredited school. Applicant holds a bachelor's degree in special education. Dr. Johnson stated the position for which applicant applied requires 9 hours of fundamentals and 15 hours of speech pathology. The information found on page 1518 showed that the program was not accredited for granting a degree. Board counsel stated this doesn't mean the applicant did not learn what she needed to learn. Dr. Guerreiro found the course list. Board counsel stated the programs are not equivalent to a board approved school, which means that the bachelor's degree courses may be counted but the online school courses cannot. Dr. Johnson found 9 credits for fundamentals. Dr. Rahe asked if pages 1533 and 1535 were the same and confirmed they were not. Dr. Guerreiro found 6.75 credits for speech, with a total of 9 hours. Dr. Johnson agreed. Ms. Rutland recommended the applicant complete an additional 3.75 credits coursework from an accredited provider to meet the number of credits needed. Applicant stated she has the additional hours but they come from the unaccredited online program. Board counsel explained applicant's options. Applicant decided to withdraw her application.

Motion made by Dr. Rahe to allow the applicant to withdraw her application, seconded by Dr. Boyev.

Vote: unanimous. Motion carried

11. Anisley Lima Diaz, file 2782 – Provisional Speech Language Pathology Assistant Applicant was present and was not represented by counsel.

Applicant received her education outside of the United States. The board staff were not able to reconcile Applicant's education with rule 64B20-2.002(1)(a) and (b), F.A.C.

Discussion:

Applicant stated she has masters in speech language pathology from Cuba.

Ms. Rutland opined that applicant has the equivalent education and referred the Board to page 1577. The board determined that the hours were sufficient at 700 hours.

Motion made by Dr. Rahe to grant the license, seconded by Dr. Guerreiro. Vote: unanimous. Motion carried

13. Alina Perez Adlana, file 3114 –Speech Language Pathology Assistant Applicant was not present and was not represented by counsel.

Dr. Johnson stated the board could not review the applicant's information because of the short timeframe before the meeting. Applicant received her education outside of the United States. The board staff were not able to reconcile Applicant's education with rule 64B20-2.002(1)(a) and (b), F.A.C.

Discussion:

Page 1595 showed the credits, which did not appear to equal the required 15 credits in speech. The Board found that applicant did have sufficient credits to meet the requirements for the fundamentals. Board counsel suggested adding to the Board's order 2 weeks for the applicant to withdraw her application or the denial would stand.

Motion made by Dr. Rahe to deny the license but to allow the applicant 2 weeks after the order is filed to withdraw her application, seconded by Dr. Guerreiro. Vote: unanimous. Motion carried

14. Megan Miller – Speech Language Pathologist Applicant was not present and was not represented by counsel.

Applicant answered in the affirmative to health history questions. Applicant supplied documentation from her treating physician in support of her application.

Discussion:

Dr. Johnson stated the board could not review the applicant's information because of the short timeframe before the meeting.

Dr. Guerreiro moved to grant the license based upon a PRN recommendation that applicant is safe to practice, and giving applicant 6 months to complete the evaluation, second by Dr. Rahe. Vote: unanimous. Motion carried

15. Cassandra Gail Marquis, file 14553 – Speech Language Pathologist Applicant was present and was not represented by counsel.

Applicant answered in the affirmative to health history questions. Applicant submitted information from her treating physician in support of her application.

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Discussion:

Applicant stated she was hospitalized, then started seeing an outpatient therapist; she has made progress and her life is different. Applicant stated she is seeing a psychiatrist and therapist in Florida. She allowed her Tennessee license to expire due to the high cost to maintain the license. Ms. Rutland asked if she could a get letter from her own psychiatrist instead of PRN.

The question was raised about the applicant voluntarily discharging herself from therapy and whether the Board could make notification of such an event as part of the condition of licensing. Board counsel responded that the Board had no authority to do so; if applicant was later deemed not safe to practice, then there are other means to protect the public. Dr. Boyev asked if there was grounds to require safe to practice when the underlying condition does not make an individual unsafe to patients.

Ms. Rutland moved to get a letter from applicant's current treating psychiatrist that she is safe to practice and to produce the letter within 6 months of the Board's order. Simultaneous seconds by Dr. Rahe and Dr. Guerreiro. License issued in error now showing null and void (asked to have this removed.) Vote: unanimous. Motion carried

468.1155 Provisional license; requirements.--

(1)(a)A provisional license shall be required of all applicants for a license in speechlanguage pathology who cannot document a minimum of 9 months of supervised professional employment experience and a passing score on the national examination. A provisional license shall be required of all applicants for a license in audiology who cannot document a minimum of 11 months of supervised clinical experience and a passing score on the national examination.

(b)Individuals who are required to hold a provisional license under paragraph (a) shall apply to the department and be certified by the board for licensure prior to initiating the professional employment experience required pursuant to s. <u>468.1165</u>.

(2)The department shall issue a provisional license to practice speech-language pathology to each applicant who the board certifies has:

(a)Completed the application form and remitted the required fees, including a nonrefundable application fee.

(b)Received a master's degree or has completed the academic requirement of a doctoral degree program with a major emphasis in speech-language pathology from an institution of higher learning that is, or at the time the applicant was enrolled and graduated was, accredited by an accrediting agency recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation or its successor or the United States Department of Education, or from an institution that is a member in good standing with the Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada. An applicant who graduated from or is currently enrolled in a program at a university or college outside the United States or Canada must present documentation of the determination of equivalency of the program to standards established by an accrediting body recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation or its successor or the United States Department of standards established by an accrediting body recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation or its successor or the United States Department of Education in order to qualify.

1. The applicant must have completed the program requirements by academic course work, practicum experience, or laboratory or research activity, as verified by the program, including:

a.Knowledge of basic human communication and swallowing processes, including their biological, neurological, acoustic, psychological, developmental, and linguistic and cultural bases.

b.Knowledge of the nature of speech, language, hearing, and communication disorders and differences and swallowing disorders, including their etiologies, characteristics, anatomical or physiological, acoustic, psychological, developmental, and linguistic and cultural correlates, voice and resonance, including respiration and phonation, receptive and expressive language in speaking, listening, reading, writing, and manual modalities, hearing, including the impact on speech and language, swallowing, cognitive aspects of communication, social aspects of communication, and communication modalities.

c.Knowledge of the principles and methods of prevention, assessment, and intervention for people having communication and swallowing disorders, including consideration of anatomical or physiological, psychological, developmental, and linguistic and cultural correlates of the disorders, articulation, fluency, voice and resonance, receptive and expressive communication, hearing, swallowing, cognitive aspects of communication, social aspects of communication, and communication modalities.

2. The program must include appropriate supervised clinical experiences.

The board may waive the requirements for education, practicum, and professional employment experience for an applicant who received a professional education in

another country if the board is satisfied that the applicant meets the equivalent education and practicum requirements and passes the examination in speech-language pathology.

(3)The department shall issue a provisional license to practice audiology to each applicant who the board certifies has:

(a)Completed the application form and remitted the required fees, including a nonrefundable application fee.

(b)Effective January 1, 2008, earned a doctoral degree in audiology, but has not passed the license examination required for a license in audiology or has completed the academic requirements of a doctoral degree program with a major emphasis in audiology from an institution of higher learning that is, or at the time the applicant was enrolled and graduated was, accredited by an accrediting agency recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation or its successor or the United States Department of Education, or from an institution that is a member in good standing with the Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada. An applicant who graduated from or is currently enrolled in a program at a university or college outside the United States or Canada must present documentation of the determination of equivalency of the program to standards established by an accrediting body recognized by the Council for Higher Education or its successor or the United States Department of Education or its successor or the determination of equivalency of the program to standards established by an accrediting body recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation or its successor or the United States Department of Education in order to qualify.

1. The program must assure that the student obtained knowledge of foundation areas of basic body systems and processes related to hearing and balance.

2. The program must assure that the student obtained skills for the diagnosis, management, and treatment of auditory and vestibular or balance conditions and diseases.

3. The program must assure that the student can effectively communicate with patients and other health care professionals.

4. The program must assure that the student obtained knowledge of professional ethical systems as they relate to the practice of audiology.

5. The program must assure that the student obtained clinical experiences that encompass the entire scope of practice and focus on the most current evidence-based practice.

The board may waive the education, practicum, and professional employment experience requirements for an applicant who received a professional education in another country if the board is satisfied that the applicant meets equivalent education and practicum requirements and passes the examination in audiology.

(4)The board, by rule, shall establish requirements for the renewal of a provisional license. However, a provisional license may not exceed a period of 24 months. 64B20-2.002 Educational Requirements.

(1) Candidates for licensure or provisional licensure as a speech-language pathologist shall submit to the Board an official transcript or transcripts to evidence the receipt of a masters degree or has completed the academic requirements of a doctoral program with a major emphasis in speech-language pathology, including supervised clinical practicum experience.

(a) Applicants enrolled in an approved program prior to January 5, 2005, shall have completed a minimum of 60 semester hours (at least 36 hours must be earned in graduate level courses). Applicants enrolled in an approved program after January 5, 2005, shall have completed a minimum of 75 semester hours (at least 36 hours earned at the graduate level). An approved program must address the areas of knowledge and skill set forth in Section 468.1155(2)(b), F.S. Approved supervised clinical practicum experiences require completion of at least 300 clock hours of supervised experience, with at least 200 of the 300 hours in the area of speech-language pathology.

(b) The master's doctoral dectoral degree must be conferred by an institution of higher learning which, at the time the applicant was enrolled and graduated, was accredited by an accrediting agency recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation or from an institution which is publicly recognized as a member in good standing with the Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada. If the transcript submitted pursuant to this section does not, at the time it is submitted, reflect that the applicant has a master's degree, the Board will not accept the transcript as evidence of such degree unless it is accompanied by Form SPA-2D, Certification of Conferral of Master's Degree, which is incorporated herein by reference, effective 3-16-94. An applicant for licensure based on a doctoral program must submit Form SPA-0002E, Certification of Completing Academic Requirements of Doctoral Program, which is incorporated herein by reference, effective 8-4-03, with a transcript. The forms incorporated by reference in this paragraph can be obtained from the Board of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology, 4052 Bald Cypress Way, Bin C-06, Taltahassee, Florida 32399-3256.

(c) An applicant who graduated from a program or is currently enrolled in a program at a university or college outside of the United States or Canada shall present documentation of the determination of equivalency to standards established by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation in order to qualify.

(2) Candidates for licensure or provisional licensure as an Audiologist shall submit to the Board an official transcript or transcripts to evidence the receipt of a doctoral degree with a major emphasis in audiology, from an institution of higher learning which, at the time the applicant was enrolled and graduated, was accredited by an accrediting agency recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation or its successor, the United States Department of Education, or from an institution that is a member in good standing with the Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada.

(a) Applicants who earn a doctoral degree from an approved program conferred before January 1, 2008, shall have completed 60 semester hours, of which 24 semester hours must be in audiology.

(b) Applicants who earn a doctoral degree from an approved program conferred after January 1, 2008, shall have completed 75 semester hours.

(c) An approved program must address the areas of knowledge and skill set forth in Section 468.1155(2)(b), F.S. Approved supervised clinical practicum experiences require completion of at least 300 clock hours of supervised experience, with at least 200 of the

300 hours in the area of audiology.

(d) An applicant who graduated from or is currently enrolled in a program at a university or college outside of the United States or Canada shall present documentation of the determination of equivalency to standards established by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation in order to qualify.

The application shall be made on Form SPA-2, Application for Provisional Licensure, which is incorporated by reference herein, will be effective March 25, 1991, and can be obtained from the Board of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology, Department of Health, 4052 Bald Cypress Way, Bin #C-06, Taliahassee, Florida 32399-3256. The Department shall notify the applicant by letter of any deficiencies in the application within 30 days after the application is filed. The applicant shall rectify all deficiencies in the application within one year from the date of such letter or the application will be processed as an incomplete application and the application file will be closed.

(3) The Board shall certify to the Department as eligible to receive a provisional license those applicants who have completed the application form, remitted the nonrefundable application fee as required by Rule 64B20-3.002, F.A.C., the provisional license fee required by Rule 64B20-3.005, F.A.C., and who have demonstrated to the Board that they have met the educational requirements contained in Rule 64B20-2.002, F.A.C., F.A.C.

(4) In addition to the application form, candidates for a provisional license shall also complete Form SPA-2A, Speech-Language Pathology and/or Audiology Verification of Employment for a Provisional Licensee, which is incorporated by reference herein, will be effective March 25, 1991, and can be obtained from the Board of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology, Department of Health, 4052 Bald Cypress Way, #C-06, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3256. Said form shall provide the following:

(a) Evidence that the professional employment shall include assessment, habilitation and rehabilitation activities with clients.

(b) Evidence that the activities performed by the provisional licensee shall be monitored and evaluated by an individual with an active license in the same area for which provisional licensure is being sought. The evaluation may be conducted by more than one (1) licensed speech-language pathologist or audiologist. In such cases, one licensee shall assume the responsibility to organize and verify that the policies concerning supervision and evaluation are met.

(5) A provisional license shall be valid for a period of 18 months from the date of issuance or until a license to practice Speech-Language Pathology or Audiology pursuant to Section 468.1185, F.S., is issued.

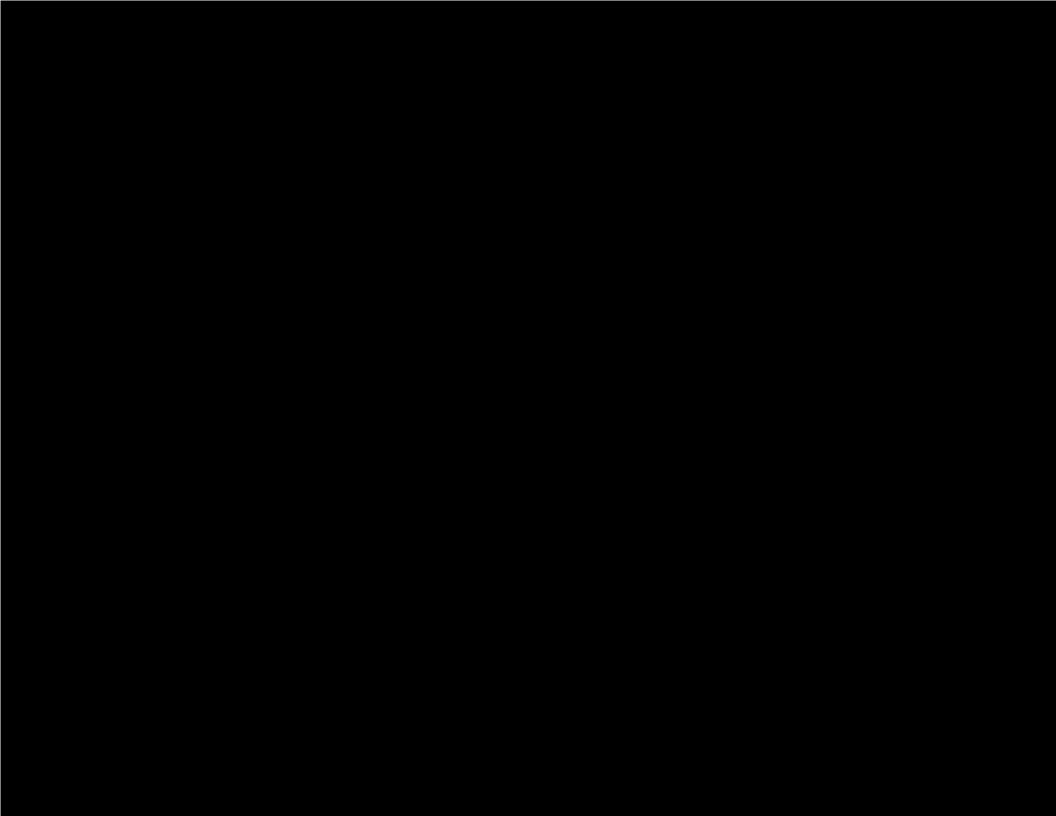

(b)Individuals who are required to hold a provisional license under paragraph (a) shall apply to the department and be certified by the board for licensure prior to initiating the professional employment experience required pursuant to s. <u>468.1165</u>.

(2)The department shall issue a provisional license to practice speech-language pathology to each applicant who the board certifies has:

(a)Completed the application form and remitted the required fees, including a nonrefundable application fee.

(b)Received a master's degree or has completed the academic requirement of a doctoral degree program with a major emphasis in speech-language pathology from an institution of higher learning that is, or at the time the applicant was enrolled and graduated was, accredited by an accrediting agency recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation or its successor or the United States Department of Education, or from an institution that is a member in good standing with the Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada. An applicant who graduated from or is currently enrolled in a program at a university or college outside the United States or Canada must present documentation of the determination of equivalency of the program to standards established by an accrediting body recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation or its successor or the United States Department of standards established by an accrediting body recognized by the Council for Higher Education in order to qualify.

1. The applicant must have completed the program requirements by academic course work, practicum experience, or laboratory or research activity, as verified by the program, including:

a.Knowledge of basic human communication and swallowing processes, including their biological, neurological, acoustic, psychological, developmental, and linguistic and cultural bases.

b.Knowledge of the nature of speech, language, hearing, and communication disorders and differences and swallowing disorders, including their etiologies, characteristics, anatomical or physiological, acoustic, psychological, developmental, and linguistic and cultural correlates, voice and resonance, including respiration and phonation, receptive and expressive language in speaking, listening, reading, writing, and manual modalities, hearing, including the impact on speech and language, swallowing, cognitive aspects of communication, social aspects of communication, and communication modalities.

c.Knowledge of the principles and methods of prevention, assessment, and intervention for people having communication and swallowing disorders, including consideration of anatomical or physiological, psychological, developmental, and linguistic and cultural correlates of the disorders, articulation, fluency, voice and resonance, receptive and expressive communication, hearing, swallowing, cognitive aspects of communication, social aspects of communication, and communication modalities.

2. The program must include appropriate supervised clinical experiences.

The board may waive the requirements for education, practicum, and professional employment experience for an applicant who received a professional education in

another country if the board is satisfied that the applicant meets the equivalent education and practicum requirements and passes the examination in speech-language pathology.

(3)The department shall issue a provisional license to practice audiology to each applicant who the board certifies has:

(a)Completed the application form and remitted the required fees, including a nonrefundable application fee.

(b)Effective January 1, 2008, earned a doctoral degree in audiology, but has not passed the license examination required for a license in audiology or has completed the academic requirements of a doctoral degree program with a major emphasis in audiology from an institution of higher learning that is, or at the time the applicant was enrolled and graduated was, accredited by an accrediting agency recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation or its successor or the United States Department of Education, or from an institution that is a member in good standing with the Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada. An applicant who graduated from or is currently enrolled in a program at a university or college outside the United States or Canada must present documentation of the determination of equivalency of the program to standards established by an accrediting body recognized by the Council for Higher Education or its successor or the United States Department of Education or its successor or the United States or Canada must present documentation of the determination of equivalency of the program to standards established by an accrediting body recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation or its successor or the United States Department of Education in order to qualify.

1. The program must assure that the student obtained knowledge of foundation areas of basic body systems and processes related to hearing and balance.

2. The program must assure that the student obtained skills for the diagnosis, management, and treatment of auditory and vestibular or balance conditions and diseases.

3. The program must assure that the student can effectively communicate with patients and other health care professionals.

4. The program must assure that the student obtained knowledge of professional ethical systems as they relate to the practice of audiology.

5. The program must assure that the student obtained clinical experiences that encompass the entire scope of practice and focus on the most current evidence-based practice.

The board may waive the education, practicum, and professional employment experience requirements for an applicant who received a professional education in another country if the board is satisfied that the applicant meets equivalent education and practicum requirements and passes the examination in audiology.

(4)The board, by rule, shall establish requirements for the renewal of a provisional license. However, a provisional license may not exceed a period of 24 months. 64B20-2.002 Educational Requirements.

(1) Candidates for licensure or provisional licensure as a speech-language pathologist shall submit to the Board an official transcript or transcripts to evidence the receipt of a masters degree or has completed the academic requirements of a doctoral program with a major emphasis in speech-language pathology, including supervised clinical practicum experience.

(a) Applicants enrolled in an approved program prior to January 5, 2005, shall have completed a minimum of 60 semester hours (at least 36 hours must be earned in graduate level courses). Applicants enrolled in an approved program after January 5, 2005, shall have completed a minimum of 75 semester hours (at least 36 hours earned at the graduate level). An approved program must address the areas of knowledge and skill set forth in Section 468.1155(2)(b), F.S. Approved supervised clinical practicum experiences require completion of at least 300 clock hours of supervised experience, with at least 200 of the 300 hours in the area of speech-language pathology.

(b) The master's doctoral dectoral degree must be conferred by an institution of higher learning which, at the time the applicant was enrolled and graduated, was accredited by an accrediting agency recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation or from an institution which is publicly recognized as a member in good standing with the Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada. If the transcript submitted pursuant to this section does not, at the time it is submitted, reflect that the applicant has a master's degree, the Board will not accept the transcript as evidence of such degree unless it is accompanied by Form SPA-2D, Certification of Conferral of Master's Degree, which is incorporated herein by reference, effective 3-16-94. An applicant for licensure based on a doctoral program must submit Form SPA-0002E, Certification of Completing Academic Requirements of Doctoral Program, which is incorporated herein by reference, effective 8-4-03, with a transcript. The forms incorporated by reference in this paragraph can be obtained from the Board of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology, 4052 Bald Cypress Way, Bin C-06, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3256.

(c) An applicant who graduated from a program or is currently enrolled in a program at a university or college outside of the United States or Canada shall present documentation of the determination of equivalency to standards established by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation in order to gualify.

(2) Candidates for licensure or provisional licensure as an Audiologist shall submit to the Board an official transcript or transcripts to evidence the receipt of a doctoral degree with a major emphasis in audiology, from an institution of higher learning which, at the time the applicant was enrolled and graduated, was accredited by an accrediting agency recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation or its successor, the United States Department of Education, or from an institution that is a member in good standing with the Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada.

(a) Applicants who earn a doctoral degree from an approved program conferred before January 1, 2008, shall have completed 60 semester hours, of which 24 semester hours must be in audiology.

(b) Applicants who earn a doctoral degree from an approved program conferred after January 1, 2008, shall have completed 75 semester hours.

The Department shall notify the applicant by letter of any deficiencies in the application within 30 days after the application is filed. The applicant shall rectify all deficiencies in the application within one year from the date of such letter or the application will be processed as an incomplete application and the application file will be closed.

(3) The Board shall certify to the Department as eligible to receive a provisional license those applicants who have completed the application form, remitted the nonrefundable application fee as required by Rule 64B20-3.002, F.A.C., the provisional license fee required by Rule 64B20-3.005, F.A.C., and who have demonstrated to the Board that they have met the educational requirements contained in Rule 64B20-2.002, F.A.C., F.A.C.

(4) In addition to the application form, candidates for a provisional license shall also complete Form SPA-2A, Speech-Language Pathology and/or Audiology Verification of Employment for a Provisional Licensee, which is incorporated by reference herein, will be effective March 25, 1991, and can be obtained from the Board of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology, Department of Health, 4052 Bald Cypress Way, #C-06, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3256. Said form shall provide the following:

(a) Evidence that the professional employment shall include assessment, habilitation and rehabilitation activities with clients.

(b) Evidence that the activities performed by the provisional licensee shall be monitored and evaluated by an individual with an active license in the same area for which provisional licensure is being sought. The evaluation may be conducted by more than one (1) licensed speech-language pathologist or audiologist. In such cases, one licensee shall assume the responsibility to organize and verify that the policies concerning supervision and evaluation are met.

(5) A provisional license shall be valid for a period of 18 months from the date of issuance or until a license to practice Speech-Language Pathology or Audiology pursuant to Section 468.1185, F.S., is issued.
